

## **VOLUNTEER PROGRAM FAQs**

**How long will it take me to register?** The registration process should take **10 minutes or less.** 

## What information do I need to register?

- ✓ Contact information
- ✓ Emergency contact information
- ✓ Top two committee choices
- ✓ Availability the week of October 14-20
- ✓ Credit card information
- ✓ Golf shirt and pullover size

**Should I visit deccgolf.com before registering?** Yes! It will make the registration process easier if you have reviewed the step-by-step tutorial and committee descriptions.

How many days do I have to volunteer? As a volunteer, you are required to work at least two shifts. Shifts are approximately four (4) to six (6) hours in length. In signing up to volunteer, you are committing to your designated Committee Chairman and fellow volunteers. **NEW FOR**2024: Volunteers who meet the minimum shift requirement will be entered into a raffle for tournament prizes. The more shifts you work, the more chances you have to win. Multiple winners will be selected after the event.

## Am I locked into working the days I select on

registration? No, but it is a helpful guideline for our Committee Chairmen. We know that you don't have your October schedule finalized five months in advance, however we do ask that you do your best to provide availability and save those dates on your calendar. If personal or work commitments arise, we ask you to call the tournament office or your Committee Chairman and we can adjust availability.

How are committee assignments made and when will I know what committee I am on? Your application is timestamped with the day and time it was submitted. Your application will be reviewed, and you will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis based on availability. You will receive an email with your committee assignment within approximately two weeks of submitting your application.

**Do I need to register early?** The tournament highly suggests that if you are interested in volunteering, you try to register as soon as you can. Registration opens to the public on **Wednesday, May 15 at 8 AM**. The tournament provides past volunteers, Dominion Energy employees and retirees, and CCV members the opportunity to register in advance of the public. To ensure you receive a spot on one of your top two committee choices, it will be best to register early!

Can I have someone else register on my behalf if I am unavailable? Yes! A family member, friend or co-worker can complete the application for you.

I have never volunteered for a golf tournament before, and I am not a golfer. Are there committees that are not golf-related? Yes! Out of 25 committees, only 10 prefer golf or previous tournament experience. There are many opportunities to interact with spectators, corporate partners, players, and caddies that don't require golf or tournament experience.

What is the volunteer experience like at the Dominion Energy Charity Classic? The day-to-day volunteer experience will look different based on your committee assignment and duties. You will find volunteers working inside-the-ropes, in hospitality venues, at the admissions gates and shuttling players and caddies among other things.

## Can I watch and enjoy the tournament if I volunteer?

Absolutely! We encourage you to enjoy the tournament when you are not volunteering. As part of the volunteer package, you will receive a volunteer credential that provides grounds access and complimentary parking to the tournament, Thursday through Sunday. You will also receive tickets that can be distributed to family and friends.
